Key Teachings About God

- ♦ *God is against those who plan evil.*
- ♦ *God is a righteous judge.*
- ♦ *God will rule in Jerusalem forever.*
- ♦ *God does not require us to fix all of society's problems, but expects us to right the wrongs in our own behavior toward those who are vulnerable or oppressed.*
- ♦ *God forgives.*

Key Verses

- ♦ *Mic. 3:8-12: "Hear this. . . You rulers of. . . Israel. . because of you, Zion will be plowed like a field, Jerusalem will become a heap of rubble."*
- ♦ *Mic. 4:3-5: "They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore."*
- ♦ *Mic. 7:28: "Who is a God like you, who pardons sin, . . . You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy."*

Key Concepts

- ♦ *Spiritual renewal begins with putting an end to one's unjust treatment of others. This is not all there is, but it is the essential first step.*
- ♦ *Oracles of the prophets generally fall into four categories: indictment (telling the people what they are doing wrong), judgment (indicating how God is going to punish their sin), instruction (identifying what response is appropriate), and aftermath (outlining the hope for deliverance and restoration after the judgment).*

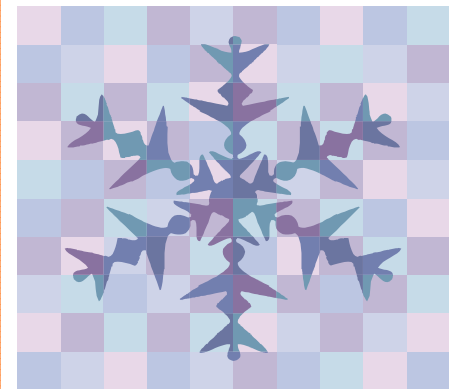
